First stop Weissgerber Museum - Tanner's Museum





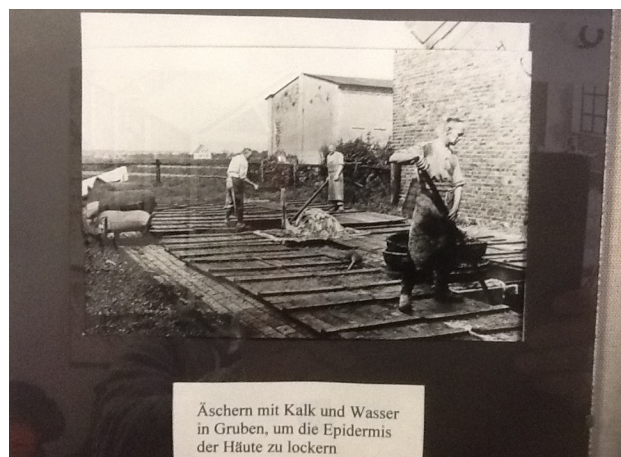
Tanner Museum - building dates back to 1700s. Farms rare in this area so had to use animals.

Used sheep skins to make clothing & materials. Talked about the process for the skins and the wool.

Went through the museum, looked at the process and the hard life the Tanners led. Stripping the skin, drying it and stretching it.



Next room, back to prehistoric times. How the leather was made and how the process was different. Use of stones to get all the fat and wool out of the skin. Described how used wolf skin and Russian bear skin.

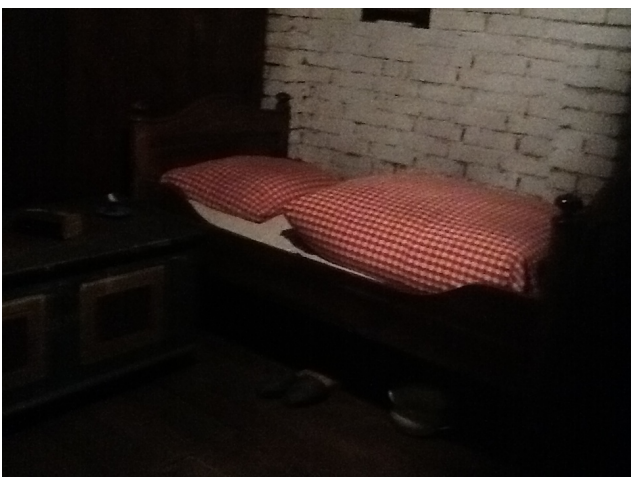




Also used skins from many other animals including fish, crocodiles, ferrets and squirrels.

Workshop and Living space





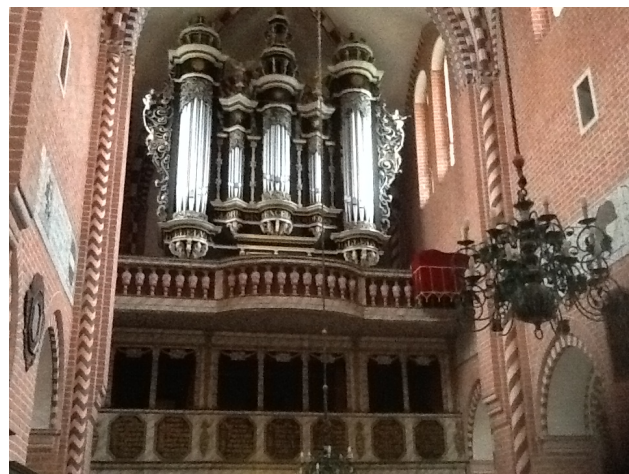
The final exhibit was the collection of doors, gates, old keys and hinges.
