Reading challenge <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read your reading book at least 3 times a week. • Ask a grown up to write a response to the book you are reading once a week. Hand in Day: Monday	Read: Can you look at a book and find any of these words? Which words did you spot the most? <div> <div>the</div> <div>go</div> <div>to</div> <div>no</div> <div>I</div> <div>he</div> </div> 	Create: Use different items to make a puppet e.g. a finger puppet, glove, sock, spoon, shadow puppet. Can you use your puppet to perform to others?	Think: Play a game with some people in your family where you all take turns and follow rules e.g. a board game, card game. Think about why it is important to take turns and follow rules when you are playing games.	Write: Look on the Internet or in a recipe book to find a pancake recipe. Write or draw a list of the things you will need to buy at the shop. 
Maths challenge Improve your maths skills. Play games: http://www.crickweb.co.uk/Early-Years.html Practise writing numbers 0-15	Collect: Look for different shaped objects around your home. See if you can find: 5 round objects, 4 tall objects, 3 objects with straight sides and 2 objects with more than 4 sides. Take a picture of what you find and share on Tapestry.	Design: Find your favourite teddy bear. Can you design an outfit for your teddy bear? Which season would your outfit be for?	Count: There are 3 cars in the toy box. How many wheels are there altogether? Draw a picture to help you work it out. 	Create your own home learning task. 
Writing challenge Practise writing, tracing or copying your name remembering to use 'and' to start each letter.	Write: Can you write a word that begins with each one of these letters? <div> <div>t</div> <div>f</div> <div>d</div> <div>s</div> <div>c</div> <div>b</div> </div>	Research: Find out about toys from the past and the different toys your parents and grandparents played with when they were younger. How were they different? What was their favourite toy?	Identify: During Chinese New Year celebrations, children are sometimes given envelopes with money inside! With an adult look at some coins and identify the number, colour and shapes of each coin. 	Practise: Find or make some number cards 0-10 or even 20. Mix them up then see how quickly you can put them in the correct order?
