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Weekly Essentials	Enrichment Ideas We encourage you to choose at least 1 activity each week over the term.  Reading challenge Read your reading book at least 3 times a week. Ask a grown up to write a response to the book you are reading once a week. Watch Geraldine the Giraffe videos on YouTube to practise your phonics. 	Read: traditional fairy stories. Can you draw pictures about the stories.	Identify: Bring in a photo of a special place that you like to visit with your family. E.g. the beach or the park. Talk about why it is so special to you. Describe what you like to do when you visit this special place.	Create: Draw or paint pictures to show different kinds of weather. Talk about what you would wear and what you could do when it's raining or sunny etc.	Listen: to music on YouTube from different cultures and countries. Talk about what you can hear. Which music did you like best?
Maths challenge Improve your maths skills. Play games: <u>https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for- home/kids-activities/fun-maths- games-and-activities/</u> Practise writing numbers 0-10 and beyond.	Read: your favourite stories. Can you write speech bubbles to show what the characters are saying?	Create: masks to wear of your favourite story characters. Can you act out the story?	Create: a junk musical instruments out of recycled materials? E.g. plastic bottle shakers or a cardboard box guitar. Play along to your favourite music?	Create: a special birthday card and draw a cake for the School's Birthday (Founder's Day) in May. Can you sing 'Happy Birthday' to the school?
Writing challenge Practise writing letters correctly. Spell words by sounding out the letters. Use Fred fingers to help you write words, such as 'mum', 'dad', 'cat', 'dog' etc.	Write: Practise writing your name. Remember to start each letter using 'and'. If you like a challenge, you could have a go at writing your friends names too!	Investigate: doubling with objects. If you have 3 toys and another 3 toys- how many have you got altogether. If you like a challenge, you could write the number sentences. 1+1= 2+2= 3+3=	Discover: Sew seeds and grow some plants in your garden. Talk about what they need to help them grow. Take photos to observe how they change. Can you predict what will happen next?	Investigate: flags on the internet from different countries. Talk about the different colours, shapes and patterns. Can you draw pictures of these flags?
