E Poem Choose a character from your book. Write a poem to describe them.			Research - the Roman Army. What can you find out about how they lived and how they trained?		
F Newspaper Report Think of an exciting event in your book. Can you write a newspaper report to tell me what has happened? Add a few extra details, and some great description to make it really exciting			Design – a piece of jewellery or a shield & weapon.		
G Diary Entry Think about a funny event that has happened in your story. Write a diary entry telling me all about it, Don't forget to add your character's thoughts and personality in your writing.					
H Book Review Can you complete a book review/recommendation for your book?			Design - an Italian meal (a super-pizza or a pasta dish) containing your favourite things. Maybe you could cook it and write a review.
