Remember to use expanded noun phrases and similes to add details in your writing.</p>	<p>C</p> <p>Be an Agony Aunt Use p 25 in your reading record to give you some ideas to write this. Think of a dilemma a character in your book is facing. What advice can you give them to help them out? Write them a letter/e mail with your advice.</p>	<p>D</p> <p>Alternative endings Think of how the story you have read ended. Can you think of a better way for this story to end? Rewrite it and let me know your ideas.</p>
