


Shaw</p> <p>DEAR MADAM: I tell the enclosed a "Double Victory" Recipe as it not only releases eggs and dairy products for Britain, but uses the windfall apples—a surplus of which we have at the present time."</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Applesauce Cake</p> <p>Mix and sift 2 cups sifted flour, 1 teaspoon soda, 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/2 teaspoon cloves, 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg, and 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cream 2 tablespoons butter or shortening, add 1 cup sugar, and 1 cup unsweetened applesauce and beat well. Add the dry ingredients and about 2 3/4 cup raisins. Turn into a greased and floured pan, and bake in moderate oven.</p> </div>
