How do you know?</p>	<p><i>Find and Copy</i></p> <p>Can you find words/phrases directly from the text that describe the characters?</p>

Give a short recap.</p>	<p><i>Setting Descriptions</i></p> <p>Write a setting description from your book – use your own words! What can you see? Smell? Hear? Taste? Feel?</p>	<p><i>Synonym and Antonym</i></p> <p>Pick ten words from your text. Can you find synonyms (have the same meanings) and antonyms (have the opposite meanings) for these words? Use the new vocabulary in an exciting sentence!</p>	<p><i>Compare and contrast two of the characters.</i></p> <p>What is unique about the characters? What similarities do they have? Think about appearance, personality, actions and values.</p>
