<p><u>Create a storyboard</u> Can you identify the key points of the story? Why do you think they are like this?</p>	<p><u>Blurb</u> What is the purpose of a blurb? Can you write a blurb for your story – but remember to not give away too many details!</p>
<p><u>Write a book review</u> Would you recommend this book? Why? Why not? Give a short summary – no more than 100 words.</p>	<p><u>Book Cover</u> Re-design the book cover – why do you think you have improved it? How important is the cover of a book?</p>	<p><u>Synonym and Antonym</u> Pick ten words from your text. Can you find synonyms (have the same meanings) and antonyms (have the opposite meanings) for these words?</p>
