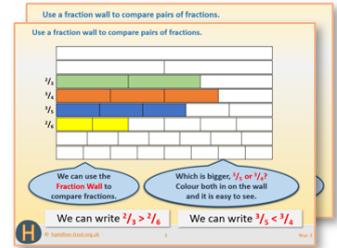


# Week 12, Day 1

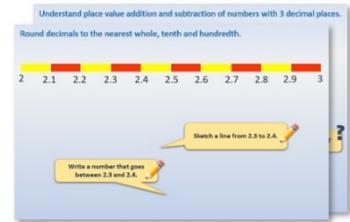
## Fractions, decimals and percentages

Each day covers one maths topic. It should take you about 1 hour or just a little more.

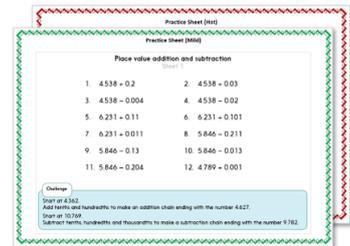
1. If possible, watch the **PowerPoint presentation** with a teacher or another grown-up.



OR start by carefully reading through the **Learning Reminders**.



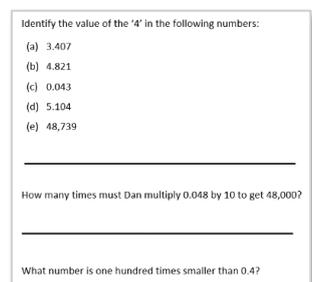
2. Tackle the questions on the **Practice Sheet**. There might be a choice of either **Mild** (easier) or **Hot** (harder)! Check the answers.

Find equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

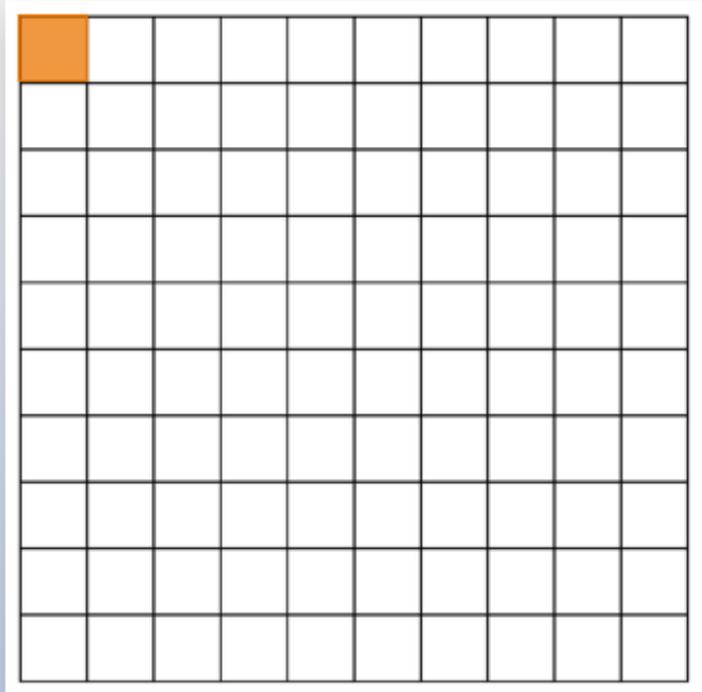
What fraction of the big square is 1 little square?

How can we write this as a decimal?

$$\frac{1}{100} \equiv 0.01$$

What is this as a percentage of the whole square?

$$\frac{1}{100} \equiv 1\%$$



Find equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

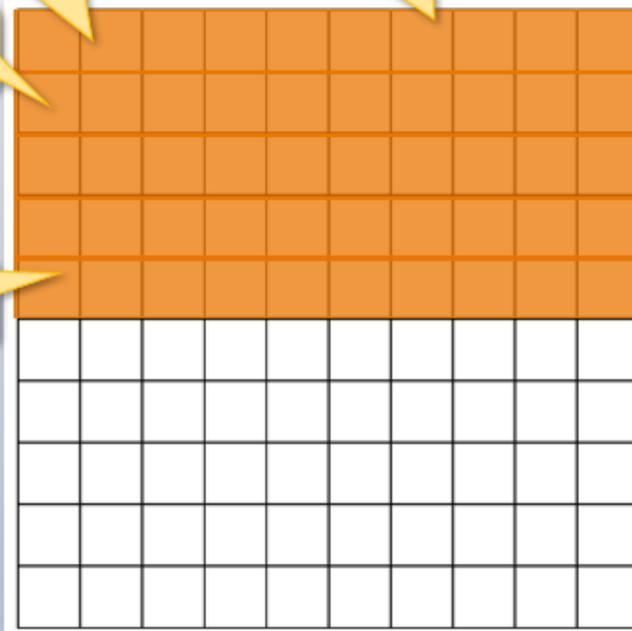
What fraction is one row?

How can we write this as a decimal?

And as a percentage?

What fraction is two rows?

And five rows?



$$\frac{10}{100}, \frac{1}{10}, 0.1, 10\%$$

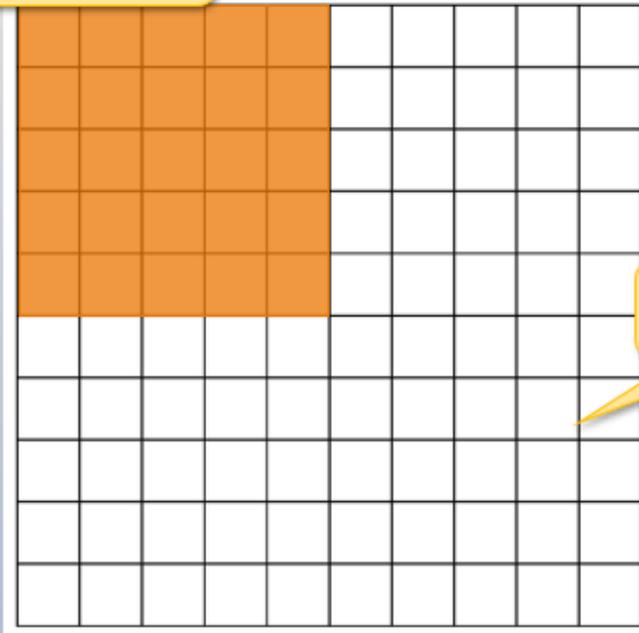
$$\frac{2}{10}, \frac{1}{5}, 0.2, 20\%$$

$$\frac{5}{10}, \frac{1}{2}, 0.5, 50\%$$

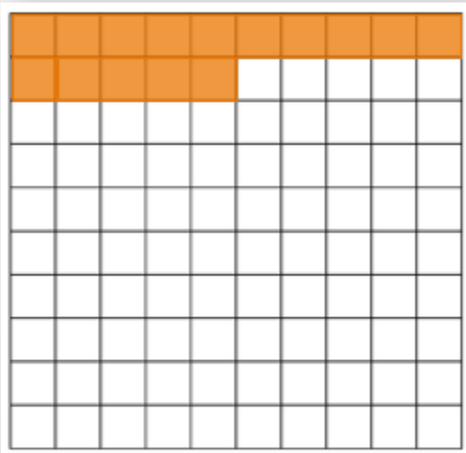

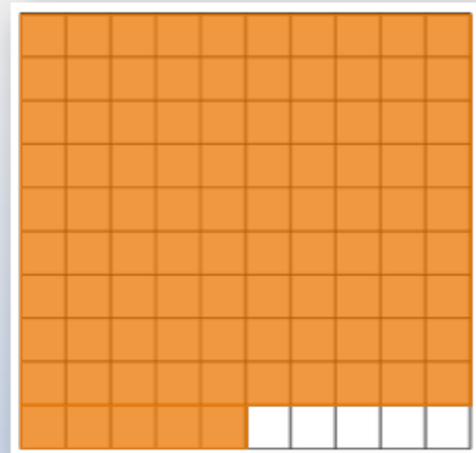

Which is more?  
How can you  
compare them?



We can write both as  
decimals (0.4 and 0.3)  
or both as tenths,  $\frac{4}{10}$   
and  $\frac{3}{10}$ , or even as  
percentages!

?

Now use equivalence to  
compare these.

$\frac{3}{4}$  and 60%

75% and 60%  
so  $\frac{3}{4} > 60\%$

0.25 and  $\frac{3}{10}$

25% and 30%  
so  $\frac{3}{10} > 0.25$

Today's tip is to use equivalence to compare  
fractions, decimals and percentages.

### What to do:

- Work together to match each 100 square picture to the matching fraction and percentage cards.
- Can you match 100% of the cards before time is up?

Use the bar model to help you to work out 10%, 20% and 50% of £80.

- I understand what percent means.
- I know the equivalent percentages for half and tenths.
- I am beginning to find 10%, 20% and 50% of amounts.

**Go for 100%**

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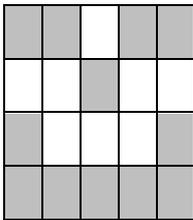

## Check your understanding

### Answers

Write these numbers in order, starting with the smallest:

$\frac{2}{5}$ ,  $\frac{50}{100}$ , 0.6,  $\frac{7}{10}$

Probably best-solved by converting each to a decimal, i.e. 0.4, 0.5, 0.6, 0.7.

---

Write a fraction which is greater than 0.4 and less than 0.5.

Various e.g.  $\frac{9}{20}$ ,  $\frac{45}{100}$  (i.e. between  $\frac{2}{5}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$ ).

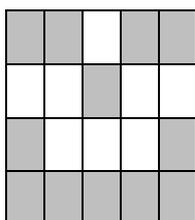
---

Write a decimal which is greater than  $\frac{5}{8}$  and less than  $\frac{6}{8}$ .

Various e.g. 0.65, 0.7, 0.25 (i.e. between 0.625 and 0.75).

---

What percentage of this grid is shaded? 60%, since 12 out of 20 sections are shaded. An answer of  $\frac{12}{20}$  shows that this has been recognised, but the fraction has not been changed to an equivalent percentage. Another common error is an answer of 12%, showing a conceptual misunderstanding of percentages.



Emilia scores 35 out of 70 in a test. Jay scores 55% in the same test.

Who has the higher score? Explain how you know.

Jay has scored higher since Emilia's score of 35 out of 70 is equivalent to only 50%.
