Spelling Pattern

When the root word ends with t then the sound is pronounced 'shun' – 'tion'.

When the word ends with 'te' then the 'e' is dropped before 'ion is added and the sound also becomes 'shun' – 'tion'.

Draft descriptive phrases; write a version.</p> <p>Day 5 – Children read a poem about Jack and the Tortoise. Imagine dialogue between the two characters and write as direct speech. Plan and write a version of the story.</p>
