## **Topic**

#### Home Learning

#### Weekly Essentials:

**Reading:** Please continue to support your child's home reading. We ask that they read for a minimum of 3 times a week. The children will also need to write a written response to the text they are reading once a week. Reading records will be handed in on Thursdays.

Maths Challenges: Have a go at our maths challenges that will be placed on our class blog each week.

**Spelling challenge:** The weekly spelling focus will be on our class blog. Look at our spelling strategies to help you learn them. These will be tested on a Friday.

<u>Enrichment Ideas:</u> Please choose at least 6 activities over the whole of the Spring Term ending at Easter. It is always fantastic to see the creative ideas you have and the ways you extend your learning at home. Please record this is your Home Learning book provided. Books to be handed in on Fridays.

### General Reminders...

- **PE:** The children will be doing Thursday and Friday. Please ensure that your child has suitable clothing for when PE is outside, that children with long hair have it tied back and earrings are removed.
- Uniform: Can you please make sure uniform & PE kits are clearly labelled to avoid confusion when children misplace some of their belongings.
- Coats: Please make sure that your child has a suitable coat with them regardless of the weather conditions.
- Water bottles: The children should bring in a water bottle form home with a sports style cap which they can access throughout the day. They will be encouraged to change their water regularly and may be taken home each evening to be washed. Please make sure your child's name is written clearly on their water bottle.
