Happy New Year! Welcome back after the Christmas. Spring promises to be another exciting term of learning for our Y4 class. Keep an eye out for diary dates and other exciting events!

Our themes for this term are:

Village Settlements in Geography and Anglo Saxons, Scots and Pics in History. Our hook day will be on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January focusing on Beowulf and Anglo Saxons. You may come dressed up for this day if you would like.

In science we are learning about **Sound** and **Living Things and Their Habitats**. In addition, pupils will be recording information about bulb growth linked to the Edina Trust Bulb project.

Pupils will be completing an exciting DT project designing and making their own alarm.

In English our Key texts will be **The Ice Palace** and **The Princess' Blankets.** 

In Music we will continue to develop their skills with **Djembe drumming.** 

We intend to make great use of our learning outside, so please make sure that your child has a suitable coat as you never know when it might rain!

Please also ensure your child has a water bottle in school. Keeping hydrated is important and does impact positively on learning.

PE is on **Tuesday** afternoons so PE kits will be required on those days. There are occasions when this may change, so it would be advisable for children to bring their PE kits in on a Monday, and leave it for the week, just in case it is needed. It would be helpful if children could use a small drawstring bag for their kits.

All Year 4 pupils will be having **swimming lessons** as part of the PE curriculum. These will take place at Whitgift school. The lessons are Mon to Thurs starting on 11th March and ending on 28<sup>th</sup> March.
