Happy New Year and welcome back to a new term. Here is a summary of the learning programme for your child during the Spring Term. We hope you find this useful.

English

We will continue to follow the Read Write Inc. Programme. We will be looking at simple words using Fred Talk to help sound out each letter sound. Children will also be writing simple words, labels and sentences linked to our traditional stories.

Maths

Children will focus on counting objects, adding and positional language (on, under, behind, between).

Topic

Our new topic for this half term will be 'Once Upon a Time" where we will be focusing on traditional and fairy stories. We will be kick starting our topic with our class 'Hook' day on $\underline{\text{Friday }11^{\text{th}}\text{ Jan}}$ when children can bring a fairy/traditional story character toy and book. PE
