Listen with attention to detail. Identify instruments used in a piece of music.

Sing

Rounds, chants, mix-ups. Songs which develop control of pitch, dynamic and duration. Sing in two parts. Use voices with increasing accuracy, control and expression.

Play Instruments

Tuned and untuned percussion. Begin to play easy parts by ear. Begin to read standard notation, along with names and lengths of notes. Djembe rhythms and simple techniques.

Improvise and Compose

Select sounds and create melodies, using word rhythms. Rehearse and organise improvisations to create piece to illustrate story. Use graphic scores to notate and play compositions.

Perform

Continue to develop control and accuracy. Perform djembes and own compositions with an increasing awareness of audience.
