Can I ask questions to find out more and check my understanding?

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

#### **Physical Development**

Gross motor and large physical development:

Can I use core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or on the floor?

Can I develop a range of ball skills: passing, throwing, catching, kicking and aiming?

Fine motor and small, controlled physical development

Can I continue to develop fine motor skills with a range of tools – pencils, scissors, paintbrushes, knives, forks and spoons?

Can I develop a tripod pencil grip?

Can I develop the foundations of a handwriting style?

#### Reading

Can I develop phonological awareness?

Can I read individual letters by saying the sounds for them?

Can I recognise some digraphs?

Can I blend sounds into words and read short words?

Can I match taught graphemes and phonemes?

Can I read taught tricky words?

Can I read phonetically decodable books to build confidence in word reading?

Can I read simple sentences containing CVC words and some common exception words?

Can I answer questions about a text that has been read to me?

Can I begin to predict what might happen next in a story?

Can I use modelled story vocabulary in role play?

Can I seek familiar texts or stories to re-read?

#### Writing

Can I form most lowercase and capital letters correctly?

Can I write CVC words using sounds I have been taught?

Can I begin to write short sentences?

Can I use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops?

Can I read sentences I have written back to an adult?
