During the morning you will be able to have a drink of milk or water and have a piece of fruit to eat. This might be an apple, pear, banana or satsuma.

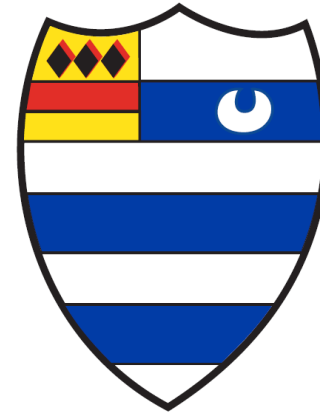
