

AVA'S CHAIN OF KINDNESS

AVA COTTLE WAS 2 YEARS OLD WHEN SHE PASSED AWAY ON MOTHERING SUNDAY OF THIS YEAR TO LEUKEMIA. THE DAY BEFORE AVA DIED SHE HAD BEEN COLOURING A TEDDY BEAR WHICH GAVE HER FAMILY AND FRIENDS THE IDEA OF STARTING "AVA'S CHAIN OF KINDNESS" INITIALLY TO HELP HER BROTHER HUNTLEY-JOE COME TO TERMS WITH HIS SISTERS PASSING BUT ALSO TO RAISE FUNDS FOR YOUNG LIVES VERSUS CANCER WHO SUPPORTED AVA AND HER FAMILY THROUGHOUT HER ILLNESS AND SUBSEQUENT DEATH.

ALL THE CHILDREN IN THE COMMUNITY WHO KNEW AVA WERE ASKED TO COLOUR A TEDDY AND WRITE A MESSAGE OF KINDNESS IN HER MEMORY. THIS HAS ESCALATED AS MORE AND MORE PEOPLE HAVE BECOME INVOLVED, FROM INDIVIDUALS TO SCHOOLS.
