Re Government's proposal to possible opening school to more pupils

Thank you to the parents/carers who completed our recent survey for FS, yr 1 and yr 6 pupils. Following on from this, it is important to make clear that Government guidance currently states,

'We know that, unlike older children and adults, early years and primary age children cannot be expected to remain 2 meters apart from each other and staff.' From Actions for education and childcare settings to prepare for wider opening 1 June 2020 (updated 12th May 2020)

We are currently waiting for further updates from the Government.

School leaders and Governors have been discussing and designing a draft plan for our school and we are continuing to ensure 'forensic' analysis of it in order to ensure the very best for all involved. We are working alongside the Local Authority and other agencies, as you would quite rightly expect us to do.

We will of course aim to keep you as informed as possible regarding this ever-changing landscape and hope to be able to write to you with more detail next week.
