Re: Mentor Meetings – Parent/Carer, Staff and Pupil

We aim to ensure communication about your pupil's progress, between home and school, is as open and productive as possible.

This year, Mentor Meetings will continue to be telephone conversations with your child's class teacher/s as a way of being kept fully informed about your child/ren's education rather than on-site meetings. This discussion will be a valuable opportunity to discuss how well your child has settled into their new class and also to discuss any specific help/needs your child may have.

The dates for these discussions are between **Monday 14th March and Monday 21st March 2022.** The conversations will be 10 minute time slots. In order to enable as many people to book a slot as possible, please choose a preferred time slot/date on our online booking system or alternatively you can book over the phone with the school office.

To book your appointment you can use your Stanford Junior and Infant School online account at <u>www.scopay.com</u>. Your account will allow you to see available days and times and book a convenient phone appointment with the class teacher.

Please log on to your SCO Pay account using your existing username and password. Select the Parents Evening heading and then use the drop down menu to select the required meeting, you can then select the day/time you want.

We hope you are able to make an appointment but please contact school if this is not convenient or if you require any further assistance.
