## **Omicron update**

Hope you are all well and looking forward to the Christmas season. We have been very busy at school with our plans and there is lots of super learning going on.

## *I am writing to you with reference to the information about the new Covid variant and the amended DfE guidance for schools:-*

Stanford is now politely requesting that parents/carers wear masks when on the playground and help reduce social contact where possible. This may mean waiting whilst someone else passes out the gate etc.

As before, please can you avoid coming to the school office, unless it is an emergency. The school office can be contacted by email and phone. The office team will do their best to respond to queries in a reasonable time frame. We will be continuing to limit visitors into the school building too.

We are carefully monitoring any Covid cases and numbers. As you will be aware, the guidance re 'contacts' has changed again and anyone who has been in contact with the Omicron variant will now need to isolate. We understand that these individuals will be contacted and informed to isolate by Track and Trace.

## Regarding Christmas plans at school :-

We had planned well in advance to ensure a range of learning opportunities were available and, fingers crossed, most of our plans can still go ahead but with news at the weekend of this new variant, we have had to amend and postpone some of the planned events.
