ALSO, USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA THAT MAY NEGATIVELY IMPACT ON THE SCHOOL OR EMPLOYEES WILL BE REFERRED ON TO THE FULL GOVERNING BODY OF THE SCHOOL.

Please do not come to school under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Please take responsibility for the behaviour of younger children whilst on school premises and during drop off and collection times.

For certain people that use our services, individual risk assessments will be undertaken if necessary.
