- Go on a number hunt around your house. What numbers can you find? How many 6s, 7s and 8s can you find?

- Building towers with Lego. Can you build a tower for each number 1 to 10? What colours have you used? Which is the smallest? Which is the biggest?
- Playing farms. Can you make a den for 6 pigs? For 7 sheep? For 8 horses? You could do this with toy cars too.
- Make hands by drawing around your hand and cut it out (or use gloves). Count the fingers on one hand then on 2 hands.
- Jump around the garden. Count up to 10 as make your path around. Who can jump and shout out the correct numbers?
