Inter-faith Celebrations – Spring 2026

These are our plans:

Easter Services

Children in **Foundation Stage and Year Two** will have a special Easter assembly in school. Pupils in **Year One** will have a visit to the local church to take down some art work and learn how Easter is celebrated in the church. As always, we love to see your home learning projects, so we are asking that children in KS1 create Easter bonnets and KS2 create their own Easter eggs. These crafty pieces can be brought into school on **Monday 30th March** to showcase to other year groups.



Eid Food Workshop

Year 3 and Year 6 will take part in a food workshop with our catering providers, where they will learn how to make some cuisine that is typically eaten at Eid celebrations. This will take place in classes on **Thursday 19th March**.

Year 4 and Year 5 will consolidate their learning about the Hindu festival of Holi– which celebrates the arrival of Spring, love and new life – by taking part in a colour run on the school field. This will involve running a course while having paint thrown at them. Sunglasses/eye protection will be provided! Pupils will be reminded to wear something they don't mind getting messy on this day! This will take place on **Thursday 2nd April**.
