Re: EYFS, Y1 and Y2 Messy Science Club

As part of our commitment to hands-on learning and curiosity, **Mrs Wardle** will be delivering a **Messy Science Club** for Key Stage 1 (Year 1 and Year 2) pupils.

The club will include a variety of sensory experiments such as creating chemical reactions, making slime, and exploring the wonders of nature. These activities are designed to encourage scientific inquiry, fine motor skills, and problem-solving. It is a fantastic opportunity for children to explore the "why" behind how things work in a fun, tactile, and high-energy environment..

This club will take place 15.20 – 16.20 each week, starting **Monday 27th April** and finishing on **Monday 6th July**.

*There are 14 places available and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. This is managed by Arbor and when the club becomes full, you will no longer be able to book a place. Booking opens **Thursday 2nd April** and closes on **Wednesday 22nd April**. If you do **NOT** make payment, your child will not be added to the club. Full payment is required in order to run these clubs. As a school we have to cover the costs in order to offer these enrichment opportunities*

The cost will be £4.00 per session. The total for 9 sessions is £36.00
